Subject: Woodbridge Town Council - CIL Receipts October 2017 - March 2018

I write to you in relation to the CIL funds which will shortly be passed to Woodbridge Town Council

Our records show that in the period of 01 October 2017 – 31 March 2018, 5 CIL payments were made for development in the Woodbridge area and therefore 15% of these payments made must be passed to the Town Council. The amount which will be passed to Woodbridge Town Council is £11,783.07 and it will be paid shortly.

The developments that the CIL payments were paid are:
DC/15/5118/FUL – Part side garden, Greencroft, Prentices Lane, Woodbridge
DC/16/3289/FUL – Bull Ride, 70 New Street, Woodbridge
DC/16/0152/FUL – Whisstocks Development Site, Tide Mill Way, Woodbridge
DC/16/0151/VOC – Quayside Mill, Quay Side, Woodbridge
DC/17/1809/FUL - 34 Grundisburgh Road, Woodbridge

The attached PDF document confirms any future receipts for Woodbridge Town Council. Payments to Parish/Town Councils are made in April and October if received have been received in that parish in the previous 6 month period.

The attached leaflet which was sent to all Town and Parish Councils which details the process of payments made to Parish/Town Councils and what it can be spent on. I would like to draw to your attention on page 4 of the leaflet which gives details on the annual report which must be published by Town/Parish Councils which have received a proportion of the CIL funds. This report is to be published by 31 December of the following reporting year giving details on the total CIL received, how it was spent and unspent funds.
