

The Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996



**IT IS AN OFFENCE NOT TO CLEAN UP
AFTER YOUR DOG**

It is a criminal offence for a dog owner not to clear up after their dog has fouled on any open public land. A fixed penalty of £80 can be issued and the maximum fine that a court can impose for this offence on conviction is £1,000

Responsible dog owners clear up after their dogs and dispose of the waste either at home or in a bin. If there is not a dedicated waste bin available, dog waste can be placed in any litter bin or must be taken home and disposed of in your grey-lidded wheelie bin.
