587. **TO CONSIDER UPDATE ON SCHEDULE**

Councillor Yule presented a schedule for May and June and answered questions.

588. **TO CONSIDER THE USE OF THE PUBLIC OPEN SPACE BY THE WOODBRIDGE RIVERSIDE TRUST**

Councillor Yule said for the duration of the Kings River project the open space will be under the control of Carters who will put up barriers to restrict access to the rest of the site. Carters will also be responsible for any insurance liability.

589. **TO CONSIDER CONCERNS REGARDING THE FRONTAGE OF NUNNS MILL**

Councillor Yule reported FW Properties own the frontage and Paul Weston said there is a covenant which is the pink line on the plan and as such this has not been built on and people cannot park on it.

There are two spaces in the front for visitors to the commercial units and also disabled parking if needed. There will be no delivery vans. Planters could be put there if someone like Woodbridge in Bloom maintained them.

Councillor Yule gave an update on the tree to be planted in memory of Charles Notcutt.
