Dear all

By way of further update, I can now confirm that we have commissioned Birketts to do webinar briefings on a wide range of planning issues for June – details below. We are hoping that our regional partners will share the cost – we will be offering these one hour sessions at £35 per delegate.

This is advance notice as the team will be working on setting these up as events and adding them to marketing materials to go out to clerks after the Easter break. This initiative picks up on input from this working group in that it was preferred SALC ran separate planning sessions rather than in collaboration with Local Planning Authorities which we attempted to organise last year. We believe Babergh/Mid Suffolk and West Suffolk did some sessions with parishes and West Suffolk did a briefing at one of our area forums on how local plans work and, of course, East Suffolk have their planning forum.

For those who came to our conference last November or who have watched Tom Newcombe's briefing on the Levelling Up and Re-Generational Act 2023 (<u>if you haven't here is a link to our</u> <u>YouTube channel</u>) you will know that he made reference to the fact that a lot of planning reforms require further legislation and that is why there is a separate session on that which includes Biodiversity Net Gain – very much a hot topic in the planning sector at the moment.

As an aside, whilst writing, a reminder we are running a webinar on BNG which has over 100 delegates registered (24^{th} April) – <u>details here if you haven't registered yet</u>. This session has funding from elsewhere so there is no charge to attend. We are hoping to have it recorded to share after the event -although we are not hosting on this occasion so that is not 100% guaranteed.
